



LTS Anti COVID-19 Pandemic Measures (Day School and TEE)

(Effective on 18.8.2022 until further notice)

The followings are the anti COVID-19 pandemic measures of LTS:

1. Health Declaration and Quarantine

1.1 For staff

- i. Please inform LTS immediately when:
 - ✧ Being tested tested positive for COVID-19
 - ✧ Being classified as “close contact person”
 - ✧ Being requested to undergo compulsory testing by the Government (Except compulsory testings for inbound travellers and those job-related regular testings)
 - ✧ Being suggested by the medical profession to receive testing of COVID-19 because of sicknessPlease do not come to the campus or stay in the dormitory (for those who live in the dormitory) and wait for instruction.
- ii. LTS recommends our staff not to leave Hong Kong during the pandemic. If it is necessary, please discuss it with us beforehand.
- iii. For (i) and (ii), the teaching staff should contact Dr. Kenneth Tsang. The clerical and supporting staff should contact Mr. Bon Fung.

1.2 For students

- i. Please inform Rev. Michelle Chiu (Chaplain) as soon as possible when:
 - ✧ Being tested positive for COVID-19
 - ✧ Being classified as “close contact person”
 - ✧ Being requested to undergo compulsory testing by the Government (Except compulsory testings for inbound travellers and those job-related regular testings)
 - ✧ Being suggested by the medical profession to receive testing of COVID-19 because of sicknessPlease do not come to the campus or stay in the dormitory (for those who live in the dormitory).
- ii. LTS recommends our students not to leave Hong Kong during the pandemic. If it is necessary, please discuss with Rev. Michelle Chiu (Chaplain) and your academic supervisor beforehand.
- iii. LTS has reserved five quarters for quarantine usage. When necessary, we will also arrange a whole floor for this purpose.



2. Vaccine Pass Requirements

- All people who enter LTS campus should fulfill the Vaccine Pass policy requirements imposed by the Hong Kong Government (Except those people who are exempted under the policy). For details, please refer to: <https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/eng/vaccine-pass.html>
- Please use the LeaveHomeSafe Apps to scan LTS QR Code at the entrance when you enter the campus. Then, please go to our office for verification and registration as early as possible.
- Holders of Vaccine Pass (Red Code) are not allowed to enter LTS campus.
- For students, holders of Vaccine Pass (Yellow Code) are allowed to attend classes. However, they are required to wear a surgical mask all the time in the campus. Moreover, they should not have meals in the campus.
- If students have difficulties attending physical classes (e.g., No Vaccine Pass), please apply for online learning to the Dean of Studies via registrar@lts.edu as early as possible. The decision will be based on the reasons and the feasibility of online arrangement.

3. Personal Requirements

- Wear a surgical mask in the public areas of the campus
- Clean or sanitize your hands frequently; close the toilet lid before flushing; do not spit or litter. Use tissue paper to hold your spit. Dispose of the soiled tissues into a lidded rubbish bin.
- Maintain social distance; avoid conversation without wearing surgical masks.
- Consult a medical doctor immediately if you have physical discomfort, particularly having symptoms of COVID-19. Take rest at home/dormitory.

4. Arrangement of Classes, Meals, Activities, Dormitory, etc.

Take a shower immediately when you come back ◆ Wear surgical masks during face-to-face group activities ◆ Avoid food sharing during face-to-face group activities |
